


**Q5 - Please describe any 'pearls' or takeaway messages.**

- I thought this was highly beneficial to me since I am considering pediatrics/neonatology.
- If you are older or African-American, you are most likely to have a stillbirth.
- Patient care following stillbirth; full range of potential causes of stillbirth; genetic data that can be utilized in analysis of cause of stillbirth.
- 50% of stillbirths are inconclusive largely due to inadequate workup
- There is a large disparity between non-Hispanic black stillbirths and the general population. There are many different causes of stillbirth, many of which can be prevented with proper pre-natal care and education.
- As healthcare providers, we should encourage our patients to be active in their medical decisions and voice their opinions. In turn, we should value their perspective and understand their reasons for concern.

- Understanding the need to explain still birth to patients and what to look for to prevent it.
