Q9 ~ Team-working skills are vital for all health and social care students/professionals to learn.


Q17 ~ Shared learning with other health and social care professionals will help me communicate better with patients and other professionals.

Q20 ~ Shared learning and practice will help me clarify the nature of patients' or clients' problems?


Q21 ~ Shared learning before and after qualification will help me become a better team worker








