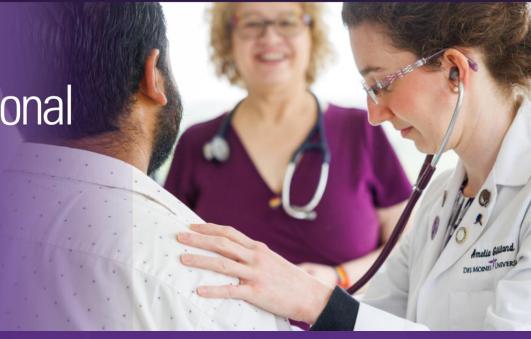


Why is Interprofessional Education important?

- Champion equity








Quantitative Outcomes: Pre-Event Survey




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
Quantitative Outcomes: Post-Event Survey





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
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Qualitative Outcomes
