
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

Let's Talk Numbers

lowa

- Roughly 1 in 10 lowans report being told they have diabetes¹
 1 in 3 report being told they have diabetes and NOT having an annual dental visit¹
 4 in 5 Medicaid recipients did NOT receive a preventive dental service²

Poor Oral Health Impacts Diabetes

Ability to eat nutritious foods

- · Loose teeth, ill-fitting dentures, mouth pain, dry mouth
- Inflammation impacts blood sugar levels
- Inflammation and oral infection impact blood sugar levels and increase insulin resistance and hyperglycemia
- 61% of patients reported being told they had diabetes and lost a tooth due to oral disease¹



















Iowa Story
